

PLYC Winter Camp Program

Phantom Lake YMCA Winter Camp offers campers four action-packed days filled with excitement, fun, entertainment, friendships, and all kinds of activities. Typical activities include sledding, outdoor games, crafts, campfires, indoor games, nature activities, talent show, singing, and much more! Winter camp is held indoors at the Erich Lodge, the Dining Hall. The Dining Hall is fully winterized and sectioned off with enough bunks for 40 girls and 40 boys. Campers may bring sleds, snow shoes, board games, and ice skates.

Winter Camp Staff

Many of the 2013 Summer Camp Counselors facilitate the winter camp experience. The staff develop the schedule and determine the Winter Camp curriculum before campers arrive. Staff are responsible for providing leadership and supervision and are dedicated to create the amazing PLYC experience for all participants.

Camper families will receive a welcome and introduction e-mail from all PLYC Winter Camp Staff before Thanksgiving.

Registration Information

Participants must be 8-16, by the first day of winter camp to register.

but the cost is only **\$225**,

Other Notes



These forms are also located in the parent section on our website. Completed forms must be sent to and received by PLYC before the start of Winter Camp.
- **IF YOU ATTENDED CAMP FOR A SESSION IN THE 2013 SUMMER**, you do not need to complete any additional paperwork. PLYC Staff will use, with your permission, all forms from the 2013 summer.

We give permission for our child(ren) to participate in Winter Camp, and understand that all medical information contained in the 2013 summer health forms will apply to Winter Camp activities. We further agree that our family insurance will cover any sickness or injury, and that no refunds are made unless the camp is not held.

New PLYC campers are required to submit all mandatory forms prior to the program start date. These forms are available on our website.

Camp Fee Details: The balance of Winter Camp is due upon registration. Winter Camp early registration cost is \$225, until December 1st, 2013. After December 1st, 2013, fees will increase to \$250.

Parent Information Email: Shortly after you register you will receive a confirmation email. Soon thereafter, you will receive a second e-mail with our Parent Handbook and Winter Camp Packing List attached. Please review the Parent Handbook prior to bringing your camper to camp. Contact the Camp Business Office if you prefer to receive this information by mail. This information is also available at our website: www.phantomlakeymca.org.

Health Form/Parent Information Letter: Each camper is required to have had a Physical Examination by a licensed Physician within 24 months of attending camp. Each year our Health Examination Form must be completed and signed by a physician and our Camper Health Form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian. These forms must be completed annually to ensure the safety of our campers. PLYC will retain all fees and not accept any camper without the necessary paperwork.

Phantom Lake YMCA Camp welcomes any boy or girl age 8 to 16 and does not discriminate against any enrolled child and family or any applicant for enrollment in admission, privilege or enrollment, or discharge condition on the basis of age, race, color, sex, sexual orientation, creed, disability, national origin or ancestry. Required membership in the Phantom Lake YMCA Camp is included in the fee. Campers are gladly received from any part of the world, regardless of YMCA affiliation. Phantom Lake YMCA Camp reserves the right to dismiss a child from the camp whose special needs we are not able to meet, or whose conduct is not in the best interest of the total camping community, without refund.

Cancellation Policy and Release Waiver

Parental/Guardian Approval:

I/We approve this application and certify that our child is in good health. Acceptance of this application is contingent upon the camper passing a physical exam by family physician within twenty-four months before attending camp. FEES DO NOT INCLUDE MEDICAL/ACCIDENT INSURANCE. Medical bills, including prescriptions, are the responsibility of the parent.

DEPOSIT

I/We understand the entire balance for Winter Camp is due upon registration. I understand in the event of cancellation Phantom Lake YMCA Camp will retain 100% of the all paid fees. In the event of cancellation due to misconduct or home sickness Phantom Lake YMCA Camp will retain 100% of the session fee. A refund will be provided, only in a scenario of Winter Camp cancellation as deemed by the PLYC Camp Staff.

Camp fees include staff supervision, lodging, meals, and program activities.

Phantom Lake YMCA Camp has my permission to use any photographs, video, or written statements from my child's experience in public relations and marketing materials including internet without compensation. Phantom Lake YMCA Camp is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal items.

I/We understand that although Phantom Lake YMCA Camp has taken reasonable steps to provide my child with appropriate training, equipment and skilled staff for his/her camp experience, I acknowledge that some inherent risks cannot be eliminated without destroying the unique character of these activities. Such risks include but are not limited to those associated with boating, waterfront activities, wildlife, and vehicle transportation. Aware of the risks and willing to assume them, I hereby waive, release and agree to hold harmless Phantom Lake YMCA Camp, Inc., their representatives and successors for all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my child's participation in this camp experience.
